## **COVID-19 Procedures**

To keep our staff and pupils safe there are Covid measures which parents dropping off key worker children MUST comply with:

- There will be a box placed outside the school office where parents can drop-off/collect any items which need to be passed on.
- Any cash that needs to be sent into school should be inside a sealed envelope labelled with the child's name, so that it can be quarantined before handling.
