1. House Captains and Vice Captains	House captains are elected by the pupils at Tilstock following a speech by the nominated candidates and a question-and-answer session. The House Captain is selected from the Year 6 pupils and will act as a role model to the other children, leading their house for the academic year. 2. Tilstock Safety Guardians	Our Safeguarding Board are a group of Year 4, 5 and 6 pupils who deliver assemblies and classroom workshops on a wide range of safety topics during the school year. 3. Attendance Advocates	They are responsible for sharing the attendance data with the school, writing the attendance award cards, updating the attendance graphs and tables.	They do their duty every Monday in worship time and Friday playtime to gather data.	RK

These four will show you and will make sure there are no disagreements. They are responsible for refereeing any lunchtime games with support from Miss Jones.
