It's always wonderful to see the excitement of topics of learning unfolding in each class – This week we have had so much going on in our Year 5 and 6 Class - Badgers – they have had a very exciting Spring term with their new Science unit on electricity. The children loved drawing and labelling the parts of an electric circuit before carefully building their own. There were plenty of squeals of excitement as the bulbs lit up! They demonstrated fantastic curiosity, teamwork and resilience throughout the activity. Next week, they will take their learning even further by adding motors and switches to their circuits.

In Art, Badgers have also been exploring colour mixing as part of their seascape project. The children experimented with combining colours and are becoming increasingly confident in predicting the colours they will create. They can now identify where primary and secondary colours sit on a colour wheel. For their final piece, they will create a painted wash background and use a variety of brushes to achieve different effects – a wonderful finish to their artistic journey.

In Maths, Badgers continue to link their learning to real-life contexts every Friday. This week, they explored what mortgages are and applied their skills in addition, multiplication and percentages to solve practical money problems. The children particularly enjoyed searching for houses in the local area that matched their budget and calculating the deposit they would need. A brilliant example of maths brought to life!

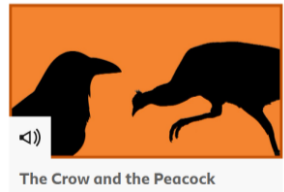
